Dear Colleagues,

Welcome to this international meeting focused on surgical techniques in Dental Implantology, Endodontology and Periodontology which will be held in the beautiful Austrian ski resort Zell am See. Encouraged from successfully organized previous congresses and courses we have invited a number of highly respected clinicians to share their experience and present their step-by-step recipes for different relevant surgeries.

Periodontal plastic surgery will be the topic of the seminar on Monday. We will learn about successful techniques such as free gingival grafts and connective tissue grafts. Different Tunnel-techniques which have greatly reduced the surgical trauma will be presented and their indications and outcome will be discussed.

Hard and soft tissue management in advanced anterior implant rehabilitation will be the subject on Tuesday. Immediate placement, bone grafts and membranes, soft tissue grafting, tissue shaping and new pouch techniques represent useful concepts to optimize the aesthetic outcome of implant rehabilitation.

The objective of the course on Wednesday is to present basic considerations, keys to success as well as long term results and complications for different augmentative procedures.

The program on Thursday is designed to provide the most current advancements in conventional and surgical endodontic treatment. New instrumentation and obturation techniques, microscopic apical surgery, atraumatic soft tissue management, intentional replantation and tooth transplantation will be reviewed.

Friday morning will be a workshop on the different options of piezo-surgery. This technology has been improved immensely and thus has widened its indications and effectiveness. The clinical use for block-grafts and other techniques of bone preparation and harvesting will be practised.

Finally, the seminar on Friday afternoon will deal with surgical, periodontal and restorative treatment concepts regarding totally and partially edentulous patients.

The symposium will be of interest to a wide range of clinicians and Zell am See will provide a most stimulating atmosphere to combine high standard continuing education and a refreshing change from our daily clinical work-load.

We are looking forward to meeting you and exchanging concepts and experiences.
